



REGISTER TO PAINT YOUR COMMUNITY OR CLUB MANAGED HUT

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1 Applications can now be made under the DOC/Dulux partnership 'Community Contribution' scheme for paint to be supplied to community groups and individuals where the paint is to be used on any hut or shelter that is:
 - (a) On public conservation land
 - (b) Unlocked and available for public use, or
 - (c) Locked but where the club/organisation has an open membership policy that would enable anyone to make use of the hut or shelter.
- 2 Applications must be made by online submission of the following form.
- 3 Only paint will be supplied by the Department and will need to be collected at the Applicant's expense from the designated Area Office of the Department.
- 4 Where paint is supplied under this partnership, a plaque acknowledging this fact will be supplied and needs to be secured to the building and left there upon completion.
- 5 'Before' and 'After' photos must be supplied to DOC/Dulux for use by DOC or Dulux for promotional purposes on completion of the painting project. All photos should be sent to communitypaint@doc.govt.nz
- 6 The relevant DOC Area Office for the region(s) your hut or shelter is located in will have responsibility for ordering the paint. Colour schemes will be approved by the relevant Area Office.
- 7 In carrying out the work, you will be required to comply with the Department's Health and Safety plan. Staff from the local office can assist you with this.
- 8 Final decision for supply of paint will remain with the Department and communicated by email.
- 9 For the avoidance of doubt, this scheme does not include the provision of labour or any other materials required for painting, other than the paint itself. Applicants under this scheme must provide for labour and all painting materials and comply with all reasonable directions of the Department and the laws of New Zealand.
